EVENT: Interrupted Residential Burglary

SUSPECT: 3 males wearing hoodies-no further details.

FACTS: On the above date and time, Tiburon Police officers responded to an interrupted residential burglary on Stewart Drive. The suspects tried to enter the victim's home by smashing out the glass of a rear sliding door. The suspects never actually made entry into the home as they fled the scene immediately upon being confronted by the residents who were inside the house. The suspects were believed to have gotten into an awaiting getaway vehicle, which there is no description of at this time.

Tiburon Police officers, with assistance from Belvedere Police officers and Marin County Sheriff's deputies, immediately converged on the area and searched for the suspects and suspect vehicle but did not locate either. An investigation into the incident was initiated, and Tiburon Police officers have been working on this investigation continually ever since.

The investigation thus far has revealed that this was a targeted event. Anyone with information about this event is encouraged to call Tiburon Police Department at (415) 789-2801.

Although these types of incidents are rare in Tiburon, Tiburon Police Department reminds our residents to use home security systems and to lock all doors, windows, and access gates around their homes. We also want to remind our residents to immediately report suspicious activity in their neighborhood.
