FACTS:

On July 2nd, 2021, at 9:21 pm, Officers responded to an alarm activation at a residence on Via San Fernando. Officers arrived on scene quickly and located a broken glass door to the rear of the home. Officers from Belvedere and Mill Valley responded to assist. No one was located in the home and at this time any loss is unknown. Officers searched the area and made contact with a subject walking in the area. The subject, Drew Michael Kent, was interviewed and could not be initially linked to the burglary although the subject was booked for intoxication and an outstanding warrant. Investigation by officers from the Tiburon Police Department resulted in evidence linking the subject to the burglary and burglary charges were added.

The Tiburon Police Department is also still very actively investigating another recent attempted burglary on Stewart Drive. In response to these crimes, the Police Department is adding additional patrol staff on the night shift.

The Tiburon Police Department encourages residents to take actions to protect your homes and property such as installing and activating alarm systems and security cameras. If you are going on vacation, please call the police department and request a vacation house check to provide extra patrol for your home in your absence.
