FACTS:

Between August 31, 2024, and September 7, 2024 there have been numerous thefts from vehicles and vehicles stolen.

On August 31, residents on Mateo Drive reported that during the night both of their unlocked vehicles were entered and over \$2000 worth of property taken, including Oakley sunglasses and a wallet containing cash and cards.

Also on August 31, a vehicle on Old Landing Road had been gone through and \$1300 worth of property was taken including a purse, wallet, cash and cards.

On September 1st a 2020 Acura SUV was reported stolen from Circle Drive. In the vehicle at the time of its theft was a set of golf clubs and accessories valued at approximately \$2,000. The vehicle was unlocked, and it is believed a set of keys was in the vehicle.

On September 5th residents on Janet Way reported their unlocked vehicle was entered and tools and personal papers were stolen. – the value of items stolen was \$750

On September 5th an Andrew Way resident reported the theft of \$1200 worth of property from their unlocked car during the night. Stolen from the car was a laptop, cosmetic bag and a wallet.

On September 7th a resident reported their LandRover SUV stolen from the driveway of their home on Old Landing Road. It is believed the doors were unlocked and a key was in the vehicle.



Because of this increase in property crimes, we ask that you please make sure to lock your doors and do not leave valuables or keys in your vehicles. If you see suspicious activities or crimes, please immediately call the Tiburon Police Department at (415) 789-2800.
