

ARTIST – MASON BONDI

Mason Bondi has been making art all his life. Born in San Francisco and raised in Marin County, Mason's father is a prominent Blacksmith and metal artist, his mother an oil painter. Working in a San Rafael studio, Mason's recent work focuses on familiarity of people and places, exploring what is seen by the artists view of the people and places continuously experienced. The work strives to both represent the normal, common, and frequently seen as well as bring forth the interior of these experiences.

Proposed work and/or site:

- Work – "Boxcar Memory" – Originally created for the event Tiburon Art by the Bay (Fall-2014), "I wanted to do a piece that reflected the heritage of Tiburon, a place I think is very special".
- Site - The picnic area at the top of Trestle Trail Park above Blackie's Pasture.

Availability/cost:

- \$5000 range with an added \$1500 going towards installation (artist proposes his father, a blacksmith as installer).
