## Town of Tiburon, CA Embarks on Broadband Planning Project

Denver, CO, November 2021 – The Town of Tiburon, CA has engaged broadband consultant Magellan Advisors to begin work on developing a Broadband Strategic Plan. The study will forge a path for improving connectivity and digital equity among Tiburon’s residents by assessing strategies to increase the availability of high-speed internet services.

Magellan Advisors’ team will work with the Town to examine opportunities that leverage existing assets and planned projects to develop broadband fiber-optic infrastructure in Tiburon. Between November 2021 and April 2022, Magellan Advisors and the Town of Tiburon will seek community input about current and future broadband needs through an online survey and stakeholder focus groups. Magellan Advisors will also conduct comprehensive market and asset assessments to further examine the opportunities for expanding internet access. Magellan Advisors will work with Tiburon to develop an overall broadband strategy that includes funding strategies and an incremental approach for implementing the recommendations of the plan.

The final study will serve as a blueprint for the Town of Tiburon to pursue strategies for expanding broadband to support remote work, telehealth, and online learning into the future.
