
ORIENTATION TO THE MASTER PLAN PROJECT

WHAT + WHY

The Tiburon Parks & Recreation Master Plan will set the course for improvements to the parks and open space system and to recreation programming over the next 15 years. Feedback from residents at pop-ups, workshops, walking tours, and surveys have helped set the direction.

Why do a parks and recreation master plan?

- Understand **needs** and **opportunities** at parks
- Understand **community priorities** for new park amenities and experiences
- Create foundation for improved **operations and funding**
- Build on the General Plan

WHAT WE'VE HEARD

KEY ISSUES

- Accessibility issues
- High speeds on Old Rail Trail
- Not a lot to do for teens and kids
- Few community events
- No activities for older people
- Children's play areas don't have easy access to bathrooms and parking
- Rules and signage aren't clear
- Not enough playgrounds

Throughout the project, we've asked community members to share their concerns and ideas about Tiburon parks, open spaces, and recreation. From the past engagement events, outcomes were formed to address key issues and achieve a community vision.

OUTCOMES

- Water access (kayak launch and swimming pool)
- Connecting the trails
- Shading and access to restrooms
- Community events (e.g. Kite Day)
- New park with children's play equipment
- Improvement at Cypress Hollow Park
- Interactive maps
- Bocce ball, or other activities for seniors
- Spaces for teens

VISION

- Safe, vibrant spaces for all
- Comfortable and accessible system of open spaces, trails, and parks
- Continuing paths for jogging, biking, etc.
- Spaces that get people outside and hopefully meeting others
- Expanded offerings for kids and teens
- Maintain the tranquil unique beauty of the Lineal Park
- Better the weak parks by adding features and interactive park maps
- Continuous trail system throughout the town
- Spaces for all ages

PARK EXPERIENCE



Create identity for park & open space system and individual park & open spaces through **naming, signage, digital presence.**



Strategically **add amenities** to support a more comfortable park experience.



Create space for **music and other performances** and establish a **public art program** with clear review roles, locations & parameters.



Convene organizations that manage Tiburon events (e.g. the Library, the Ranch, the Town, and the Chamber of Commerce) to work together and **produce great events for all.**

ANYTHING ELSE?



RECREATION




Focus on improving **recreational opportunities for teens and seniors**, while maintaining high-quality experience for all members of the community.



Increase community awareness of and **programming** at The Ranch, and bring the Community Room at City Hall back into use.



Add and enhance playgrounds distributed throughout Tiburon, to create walkable playgrounds for many residents.



Strategically develop **recreation amenities** that meet community needs. These include pickleball, tennis, and areas for multiuse play.



Explore the feasibility of developing a **small outdoor public pool**, and explore options to improve Tiburon residents' ease of use of **swimming pools** at Strawberry, Mill Valley, Tiburon Peninsula Club.



Provide kayak/SUP launch; work with the Town of Belvedere to create good water access from Beach Road, and work with the County to improve water access at Paradise Beach Park.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Consider the potential for **system-wide** changes to Tiburon Parks & Recreation. What do you think of these ideas? Place a dot next to the things that you think are top priorities, and also share other ideas below.

ACCESS + VISIBILITY



Improve **awareness** of parks, which amenities and facilities are available at them, and how to access them.



Make improvements to the **Old Rail Trail** to optimize safety for all users. Where adequate space exists, **provide separate trails for bikes & pedestrians**. Elsewhere, design for slow speeds and establish clear understanding of shared space.



Improve **safe access** across Tiburon Boulevard to Richardson Bay Park, especially from Avenida Miraflores intersection with Tiburon Boulevard (at Del Mar School).

ANYTHING ELSE?



ENVIRONMENT



Create **rain gardens** paired with paths downtown, where flooding has been a persistent problem. Connect to Belvedere resilience improvements along the shoreline.



Incorporate **sea level rise adaptation** into park design at Richardson Bay, including consideration of the drainage through Blackie's Pasture and nature-based improvements at Greenwood Beach.



Incorporate **stormwater infiltration** into design of Richardson Bay Park.



Create a **community garden** and work out logistics of maintenance.




